

## FELLOWSHIP HALLS

When something happens at a fellowship hall, what does it usually involve? If your answer is donuts, fried chicken, sports, and such then please read these fourteen verses (Acts 2:42; 1 Cor. 1:9; 10:20; 2 Cor. 6:14; 8:4; Gal. 2:9; Eph. 3:9; 5:11; Philip. 1:5; 2:1; 3:10; 1 Jn. 1:3, 6, 7). These are all of the New Testament passages which use the English word “fellowship” (in the NKJV). After reading those passages answer these questions. Which passage(s) teaches--

1. Christians fellowshiping by gathering to socialize?
2. the church had fellowship by participating in sports? (People LOVED sports and theatre back then)
3. that fellowship includes eating our daily bread together?

Today, the word “fellowship” is used differently than it was used in the Bible. Bible “fellowship,” as seen in the above passages, focused on united spiritual work and only occurred between faithful Christians.
