- Hospitality (Acts 2:46; 1 Pet. 4:9)



- Judging, forbidding (Col. 2:16; 1 Tim. 4:1-3)

2. Lack of knowledge reveals the answer

- Ongoing problem (1 Kg. 13:8-9; 2 Kg. 22:8; Hos. 4:6; Mt. 22:29)
- Why trust the Bible? (2 Pet. 1:18-19)
- Purpose of baptism (Acts 19:5)

"He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. Mk. 16:16

Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Acts 2:38

'And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.' Acts 22:16

There is also an antitype which now saves us--baptism (not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, 1 Peter 3:21
