praying in the Spirit (v20; 1 Thess. 5:17)

“in the Spirit”

- Spirit:
walk in the Spirit (Gal. 5:25)
baptized in the name of the Spirit (Mt. 28:19)
- Son:
obey in the Lord (Eph. 6:1)
baptized in name of the Son (Mt. 28:19)
- Father:
rejoice in God (Rom. 5:11)
baptized in the name of the Father (Mt. 28:19)
